



## EmpoweringHer Future Mentorship Program

Casa Esperanza's mission is to provide homeless women and children in the Bakersfield area with an innovative and holistic program in a sustainable model that supports their transition to permanent housing and stable employment. Casa Esperanza's EmpoweringHer Future Mentorship Program is central to core Programming, and every mother is invited to participate.

Casa Esperanza envisions participants gaining the confidence, skills, and knowledge they need to rebuild their lives through meaningful interactions with their mentors. Mentors through lived experience can assist mothers in becoming financially independent and self-sufficient, pursuing meaningful careers, and creating a stable and nurturing environment for themselves and their families.

- Casa Esperanza EmpoweringHer Future Mentorship Program aims to improve sustainable outcomes to rebuild their lives and achieve financial stability.
- Within 1 year of completing the Casa Esperanza EmpoweringHer Future Program, 90% of participants will have demonstrated significant progress in achieving financial independence.
- The Casa Esperanza EmpoweringHer Future Mentorship Program is designed to be an initiative that provides ongoing support and resources to single mothers.

Casa Esperanza's EmpoweringHer Future Mentorship Program expects mentors to contribute dedicated time to be effective in the lives of the mentees and their families during programming at Casa Esperanza. Mentorship engagement will be a minimum of 1 year. Expectations of engagement are weekly phone check-ins and monthly outings offering support and guidance to the Mentees. Mentors will be providing support, family enrichment activities, personal and professional goal guidance and modeling self-sufficiency through lived experience.

Mentors will receive orientation, training and resources, ongoing support from Casa Esperanza professional community, flexible scheduling, and enrichment activities.
